The Institute for Education is accepting applications submitted online as from **4.30pm of 19th May 2021** for the part-time online course *Master in Applied Educational Leadership* starting in **October 2021**. Applications will be on a first-come first-served basis and limited to the first twenty-five (25) eligible applicants.

Course Details:

This programme is targeted towards leaders in educational settings who are interested in further developing their professional knowledge. It is also intended for those professionals who wish to pursue a career as a leader, manager or administrator in an educational setting. The main target audience for this programme are those aiming to apply for Head of School.

Applicants following this programme will have the possibility to exit with a:

- Postgraduate Certificate in Applied Educational Leadership (upon completion of 30 ECTS)
- Postgraduate Diploma in Applied Educational Leadership (upon completion of 60 ECTS)

Get Qualified Scheme

This course falls under the Get Qualified Scheme, an initiative supporting the achievement of qualifications and certifications required by industry. Upon successful completion of the qualification the student may be entitled to benefit from a tax credit to recover part of the costs incurred throughout their studies.

This Scheme is administered by the Ministry for Education and is independent from the Institute for Education.

Minimum entry requirements

Applicants are required to be in possession of a minimum of **ONE** of the following:

- a) A Bachelor of Education (MQF Level 6 with a minimum of 180 ECTS, or equivalent) and evidence of five (5) years¹ teaching experience in a licensed school;

OR

- b) A Bachelor Degree (MQF Level 6 with a minimum of 180 ECTS, or equivalent) and PGCE (or equivalent) and evidence of five (5) years² teaching experience in a licensed school;

OR

- c) A Master Degree (MQF Level 7 with a minimum of 90 ECTS, or equivalent) and a Permanent Teacher's Warrant together with evidence of five (5) years³ teaching experience in a licensed school;

OR

- d) A full MQF Level 5 qualification in Education (with a minimum of 120 ECTS, or equivalent) in addition to a Permanent Teacher's Warrant together with evidence of ten (10) years⁴ of teaching experience in a licensed school. Applicants applying under this criteria will also be invited for an interview to assess their eligibility for the programme.

Language Requirement for International Applicants

In addition to the above requirements, international applicants are required to demonstrate English language proficiency with an Academic IELTS score of 6.5, or an equivalent score from another recognised international proficiency examination.

Fees

Upon receiving the acceptance letter by the Institute, applicants from countries in the European Union (EU), Switzerland and countries in the European Economic Area (EEA) are required to pay €750 per academic year.

International applicants who are not from the EU, Switzerland or from a country within the EEA are required to pay in full the total cost of the course; €9,000.
