The Institute for Education is accepting applications submitted online as from **4:30pm of 18 May 2022** for the part-time blended course Postgraduate Certificate in Assessment for Learning Teaching Strategies (MQF 7, 30 ECTS) commencing in **September 2022**. Applications will be on a first-come first-served basis. **Work experience is only verified against: GP47 or Jobsplus Employment History. CVs and letters of reference are not considered as proof of experience.**

Course Details

Assessment for Learning is the underpinning pedagogy which encompasses strategies that if adopted enhance the experience of teaching and learning. This course is intended to enable participants to acquire the necessary knowledge, skills and competences to function effectively in the classroom.

Minimum Entry requirements

Applicants interested in following this programme are required to satisfy the following eligibility criteria:

1a. A Bachelor of Education (MQF 6, 240 ECTS);

OR

1b. A Bachelor's degree (MQF Level 6 with a minimum of 180 ECTS) in addition to a Postgraduate Certificate in Education (MQF 6);

AND

2. Proof of employment within a licensed State School - Primary, Middle, Secondary (GP47 or Jobsplus Employment History)



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Language Requirement for International Applicants

In addition to the above requirements, international applicants are required to demonstrate English language proficiency with an Academic IELTS score of 6.5, or an equivalent score from another recognised international proficiency examination.

Technological Requirements

All accepted course participants must ensure that they have a strong internet connection and a working microphone and camera for synchronous (live) online sessions.

Student Agreement

As from academic year 2022-2023, accepted applicants which will be enrolled on a qualification programme will be required to endorse a Student Agreement. The purpose of this agreement is to define the conditions of acceptance to undertake studies at the IfE. By signing the agreement both the IfE and the course participant will be agreeing to the stipulated conditions defining the relationship for the duration of studies.

Interested applicants are kindly asked to submit an online application by following this [link](#). Deadline for submission of applications is **Wednesday 15 June 2022**. Places are on a first-come first served basis and limited to the first 6 eligible applicants per College (State Schools only).
