The Institute for Education is accepting late applications submitted online **as from 09:00hrs of 9th June 2021** for the part-time blended course *Master of Education (MQF 7, 90 ECTS)* starting in **October 2021**. Applications are limited and will be selected on a first-come first-served basis.

Course Details

This programme is targeted towards individuals who wish to enhance their skills and competences in pedagogy. The target audience is either graduates wishing to join to education sector, or persons already within education sector with an interest to follow an initial teacher training programme. It aims to equip participants with the necessary tools and competences to teach effectively in the 21st century classroom whilst fostering a supportive and inclusive environment for learning.

Subject specialisations currently on offer include:

- English
- Hospitality
- Mathematics
- Business Education and Retail
- Health and Social Care

Exit Qualification

Applicants following this programme may exit the qualification and will be entitled to a Postgraduate Diploma in Education (MQF 7, 60 ECTS) upon successfully completing two years of this programme.

Minimum Entry requirements

Applicants interested in following this programme are required to satisfy the eligibility criteria as indicated in the Annex at the end of this circular.

Language Requirement for International Applicants

In addition to the above requirements, international applicants are required to demonstrate English language proficiency with an Academic IELTS score of 6.5, or an equivalent score from another recognised international proficiency examination.

Fees

Upon receiving the acceptance letter by the Institute, applicants from countries in the European Union (EU), Switzerland and countries in the European Economic Area (EEA) are required to pay €750 on an annual basis.

International applicants who are not from the EU, Switzerland or from a country within the EEA are required to pay in full the total cost of the course; €9,000. For further details kindly refer to the Institute's [Tuition Fees Policy](#). Modes and methods of payment will be communicated to the accepted applicants.

Get Qualified Scheme

This course falls under the Get Qualified Scheme, an initiative supporting the achievement of qualifications and certifications required by industry. Upon successful completion of the qualification the student may be entitled to benefit from a tax credit to recover part of the costs incurred throughout their studies.

<p>English</p>	<p>1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5, or equivalent) in Maltese, English Language and Mathematics;</p> <p>AND</p> <p>2. A Bachelor Degree (MQF Level 6 with a minimum of 180 ECTS) in English with a minimum of 60 ECTS in English Language and Literature.</p>
<p>Hospitality</p>	<p>1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5, or equivalent) in Maltese, English Language and Mathematics</p> <p>AND</p> <p>2. A Bachelor Degree (MQF Level 6 with a minimum 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 60 ECTS in Hospitality or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education.*</p> <p>*Applicants in possession of a degree deemed relevant though lacking specific modules in hospitality subject content may be accepted on the programme on the condition that additional modules are followed as part of their studies.</p>

<p>Mathematics</p>	<p>1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5, or equivalent) in Maltese, English Language and Mathematics;</p> <p>AND</p> <p>2. A Bachelor degree (MQF Level 6 with a minimum of 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 60 ECTS in Mathematics.</p>
<p>Business Education and Retail</p>	<p>1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5, or equivalent) in Maltese, English Language and Mathematics;</p> <p>AND</p> <p>2. A Bachelor Degree (MQF Level 6 with a minimum of 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 60 ECTS in Business Studies, Accounts, Retail or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education.</p>
<p>Health and Social Care</p>	<p>1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5, or equivalent) in Maltese, English Language and Mathematics;</p> <p>AND</p> <p>2. A Bachelor Degree (MQF Level 6 with a minimum of 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 60 ECTS in Health and Social Care or Home Economics or Physical Education or Psychology or Sociology or Health Care profession or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education.*</p> <p>*Applicants in possession of a degree deemed relevant though lacking specific modules in Health and Social Care subject content may be accepted on the programme on the condition that additional modules are followed as part of their studies.</p>
