The Institute for Education is accepting last minute applications submitted online as from **09:00hrs of 26th July 2021** for the part-time blended-learning course *Master of Science in STEM Education and Engagement* starting in **October 2021**. Applications are limited and will be selected on a first-come-first-served basis.

Course Details:

Educational institutions, entities and organisations have a growing demand for people to communicate and engage with audiences in the areas of science, technology, engineering and mathematics. This programme will provide course participants with a range of tools and strategies relevant to the area of STEM education and engagement. This programme is offered through a combination of online learning and weekend workshops.

Applicants following this programme will have the possibility to exit with a:

- Postgraduate Certificate in STEM Education and Engagement (upon completion of 30 ECTS)
- Postgraduate Diploma in STEM Education and Engagement (upon completion of 60 ECTS)

Get Qualified Scheme

This course falls under the Get Qualified Scheme, an initiative supporting the achievement of qualifications and certifications required by industry. Upon successful completion of the qualification the student may be entitled to benefit from a tax credit to recover part of the costs incurred throughout their studies.

This Scheme is administered by the Ministry for Education and is independent from the Institute for Education.

Minimum entry requirements

Applicants are required to be in possession of a minimum of the following:

- a) An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5, or equivalent) or higher in English;

AND

- b) A Bachelor Degree at MQF Level 6 (minimum of 180 ECTS or equivalent), or higher in the areas of Science or Technology or Engineering or Mathematics, or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education.

Language Requirement for International Applicants

In addition to the above requirements, international applicants are required to demonstrate English language proficiency with an Academic IELTS score of 6.5, or an equivalent score from another recognised international proficiency examination.

Fees

Upon receiving the acceptance letter by the Institute, applicants from countries in the European Union (EU), Switzerland and countries in the European Economic Area (EEA) are required to pay €1,400 per academic year.

International applicants who are not from the EU, Switzerland or from a country within the EEA are required to pay in full the total cost of the course; €16,800.
