The Institute for Education (IfE) is accepting applications submitted online for the Introductory Course for Supply Teachers (Award) (MQF 6, 15 ECTS) commencing in July 2025. Whilst applications are on a first come first-serve basis, preference will be given to those already engaged as supply teachers.

This award will be offered twice during academic year 2025-2026. There will be a second intake commencing in October 2025.

Course Details

The Memorandum of Understanding between the Government of Malta and the Malta Union of Teachers dated 26th May 2009 states that Supply Teachers who do not have a teacher's qualification that is recognised by the competent authority will, by not later than the second consecutive and complete scholastic year in employment, be obliged to attend a basic introductory course as approved by the Education Authorities. Such course will take place outside school hours. All such employees will be obliged to attend and participate actively in this course at any time as may be determined by the Directorate for Educational Services (DES), without the right to claim any compensation, and any course costs will be covered by the employee. Failure to attend and actively participate in such course will lead to the termination of contract of employment. This course alone does not entitle participants to apply for the position of regular teacher. More information about the course structure can be found here.

Minimum Entry Requirements

Applicants are to be engaged as Supply Teachers and currently teaching in a licensed school at compulsory education level.

Evidence of employment will be verified against a GP47 and/or Jobsplus Employment History. CVs and letters of reference will not be considered.
